



HOUSE POLICY ON SERVING OF ALCOHOL

All Strathmere Managers, bartenders and servers 18 years of age and older are Smart Serve trained.

Guests under the legal drinking age will NOT be served any alcohol. For guests under the age of 25, expect to show Age of Majority or Driver's License.

Strathmere will not serve doubles or triples. Only single drinks will be sold (exception is martinis).

Strathmere will not over-serve its guests and will practice "The Duty of Care" laws ensuring everyone's safety.

Under the Occupiers' Liability Act, Strathmere and the host(s) of the event could be held liable for failing to ensure that the premises are safe for guests - SOBER OR INTOXICATED!

A guest will be refused entry or asked to leave the property for the following reasons, but not limited to:

- Purchasing alcohol for a minor or an intoxicated guest
- Possession of alcohol not purchased through Strathmere's license
- Possession, trafficking or use of narcotics
- Intoxication
- Behavior of an aggressive nature
